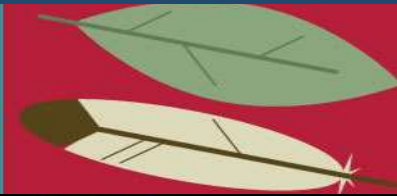

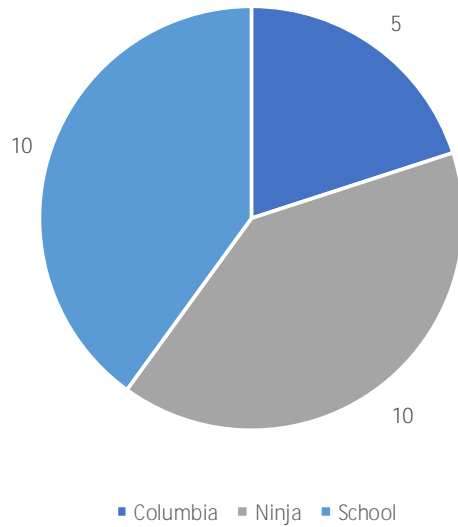

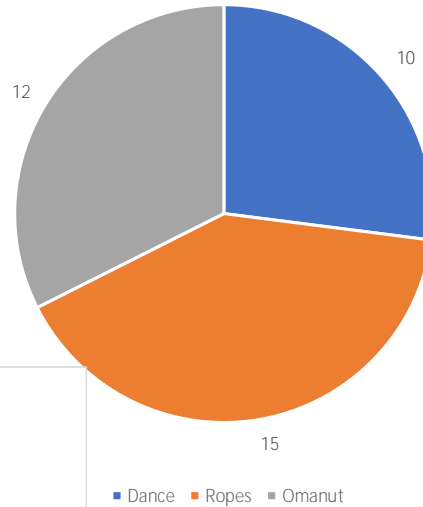
Would You Prefer One of These Chugims or School?

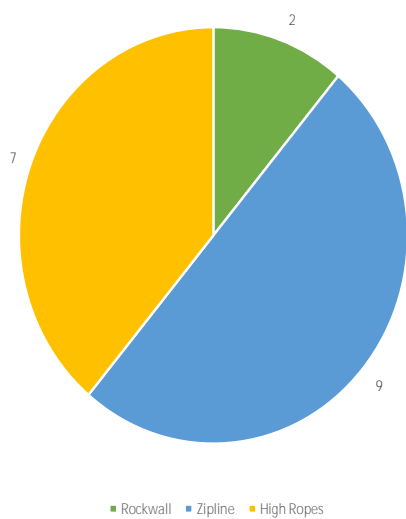

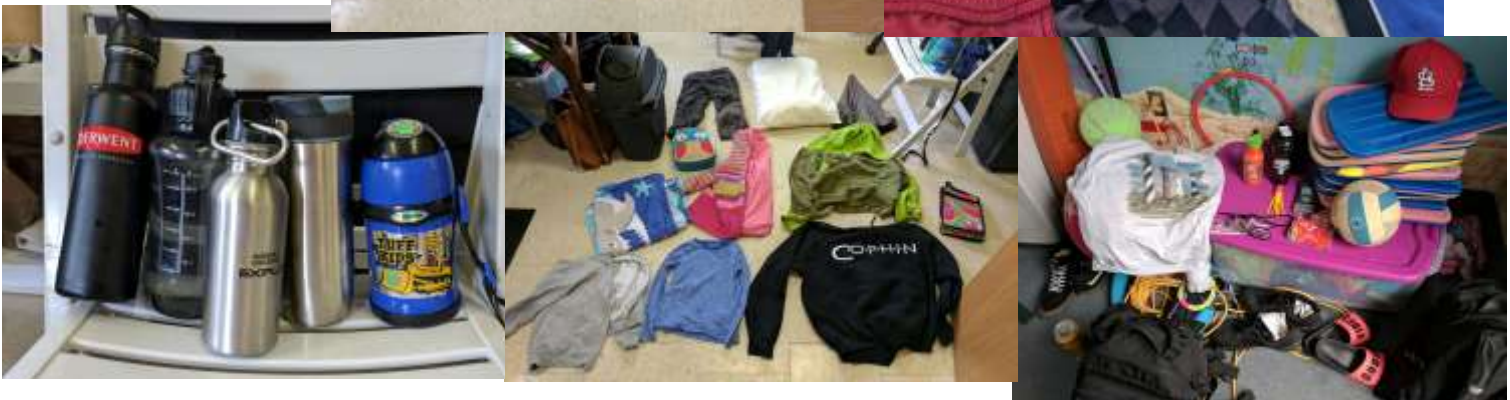
